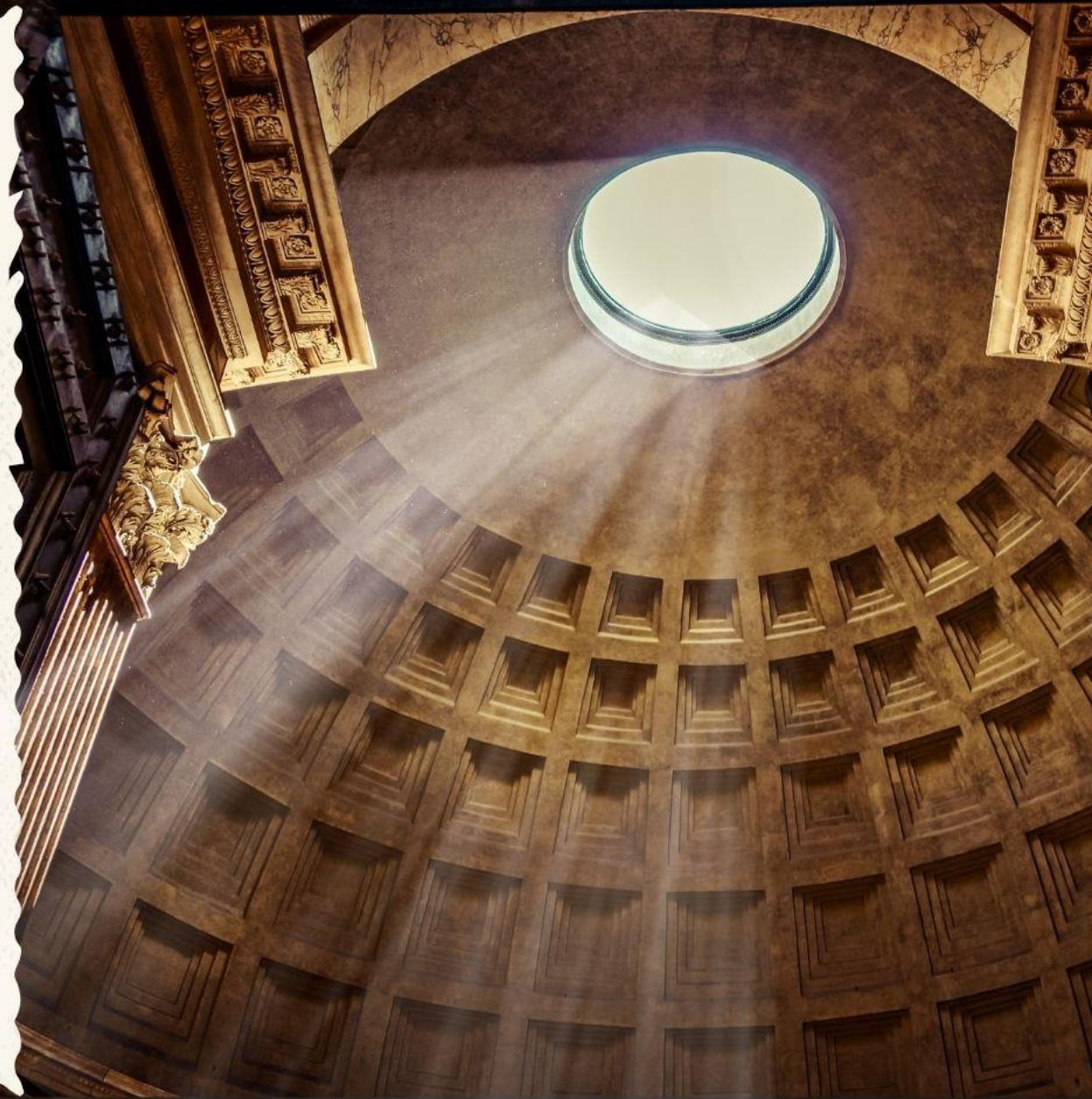

Christ Jesus”









**“Justified” means:**

unrighteous party.





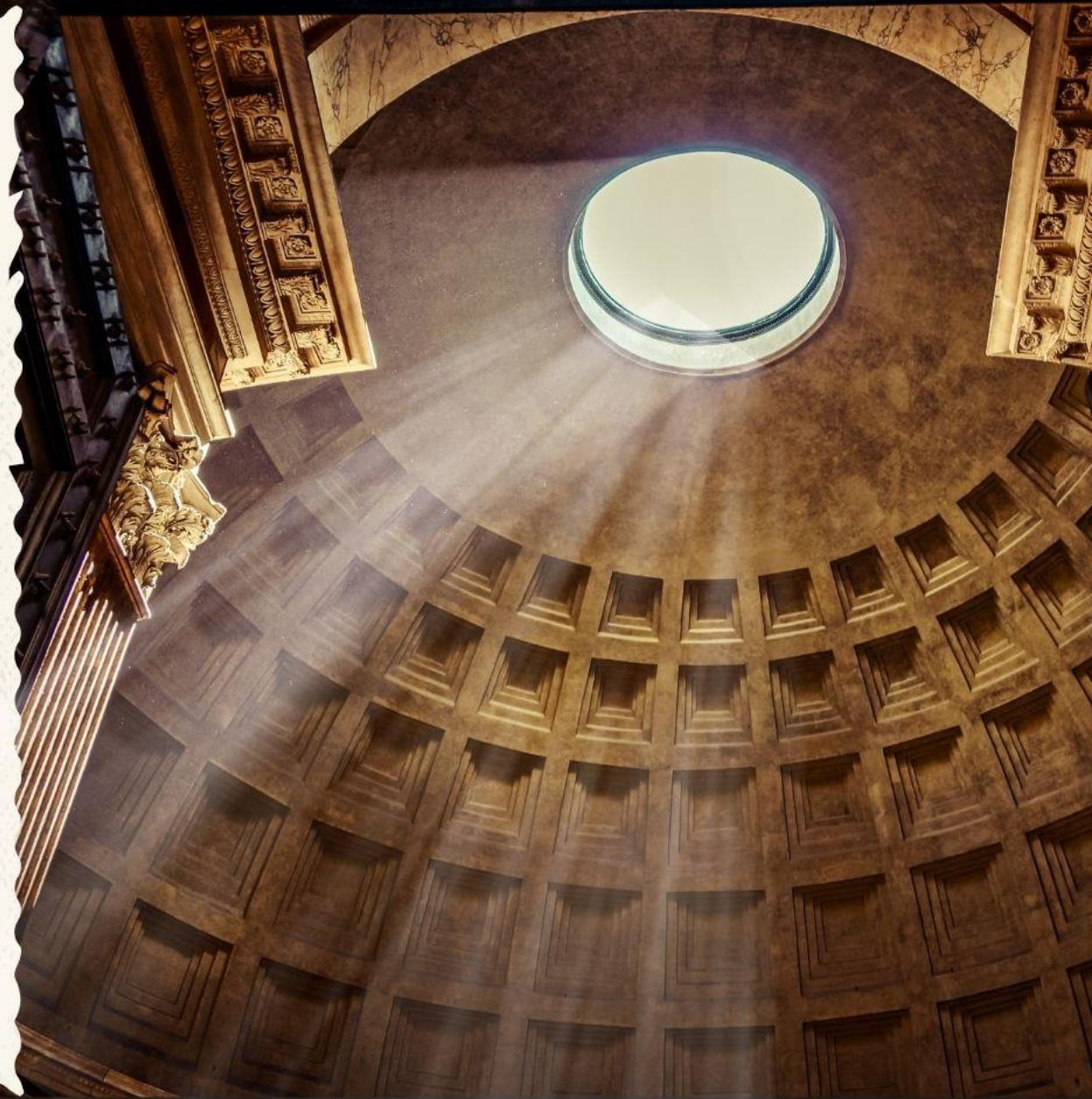


**The righteousness

**“Redemption” means:**

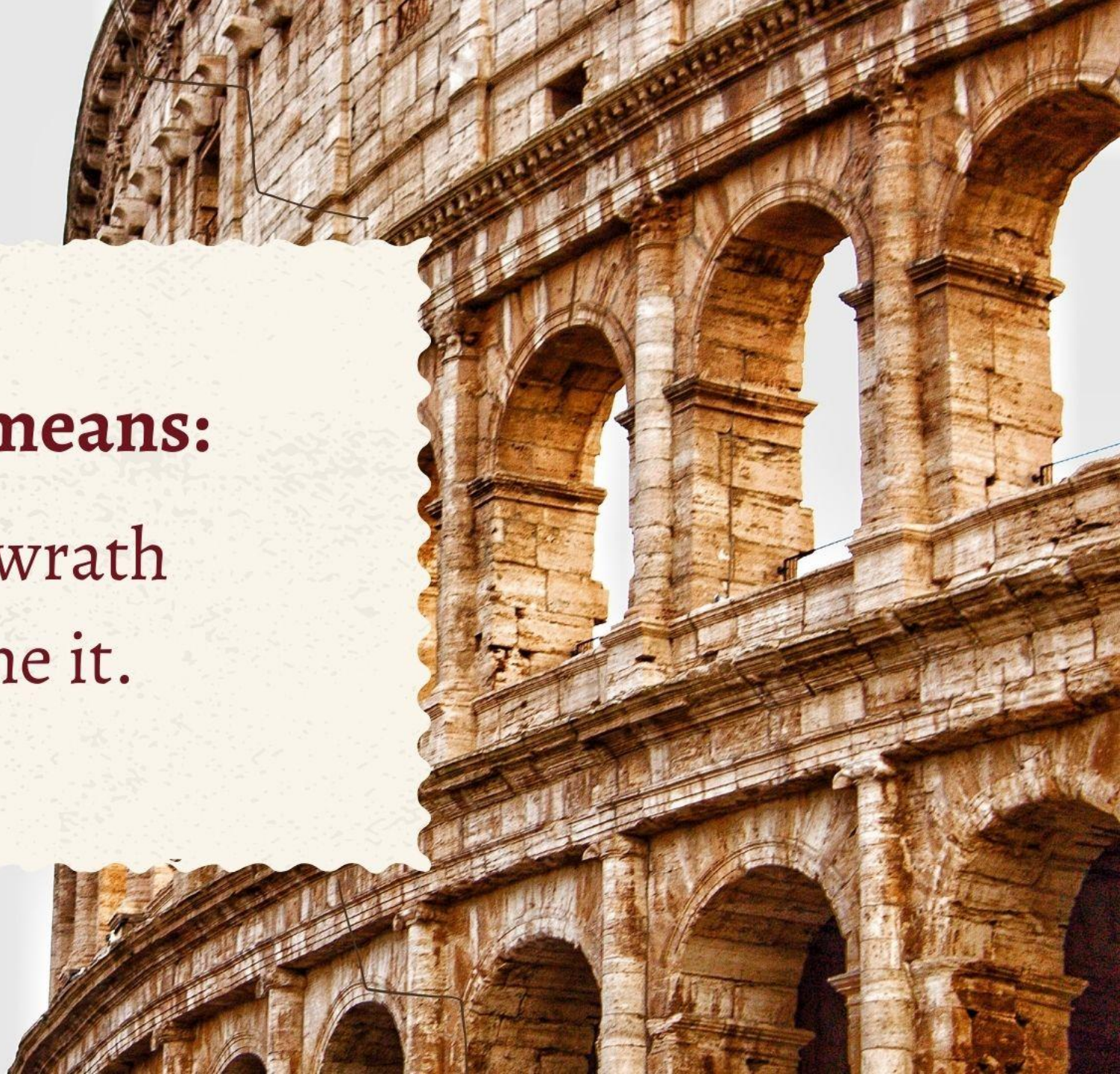

to purchase out of;
