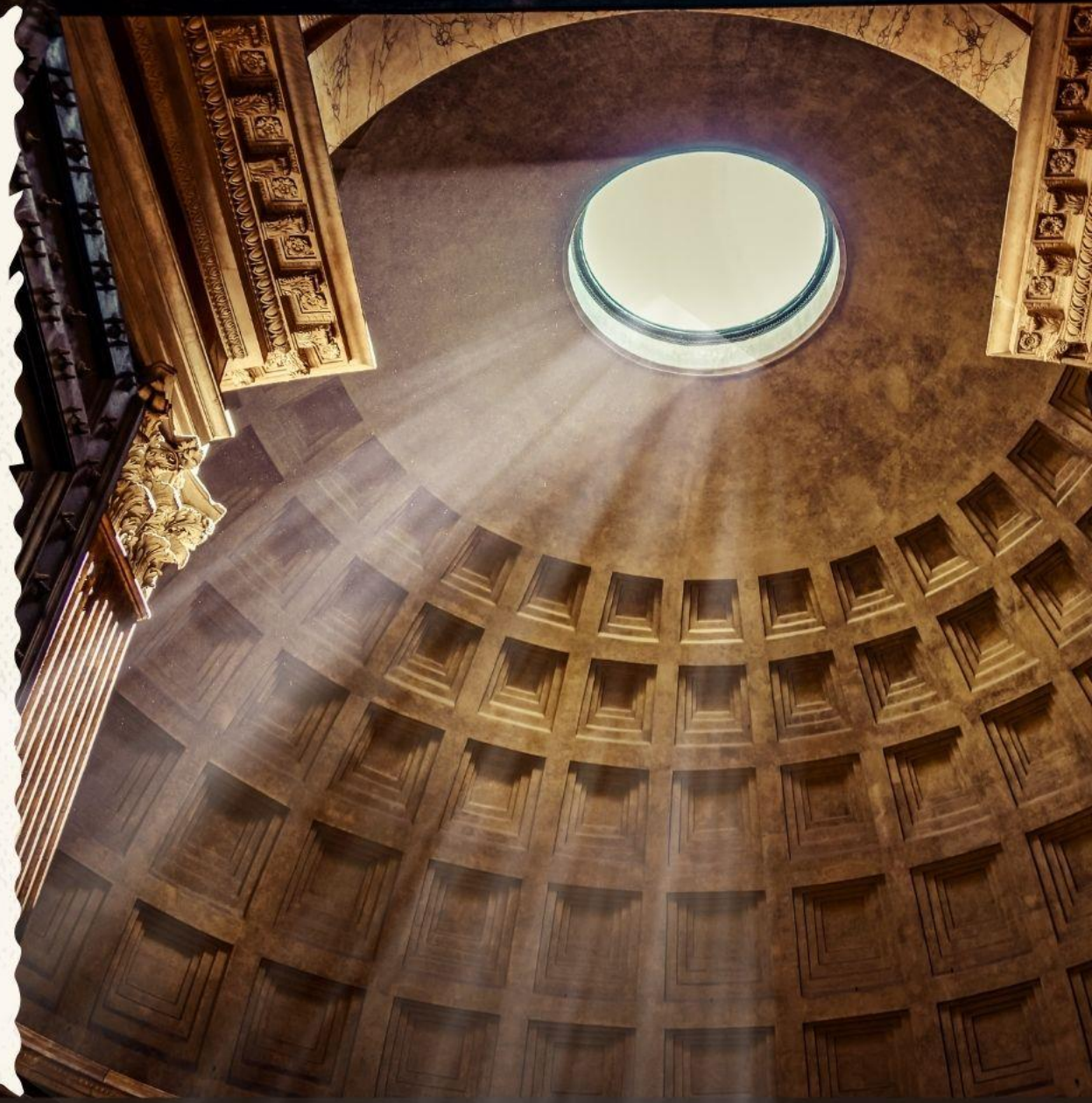
I. ABRAHAM JUSTIFIED BY FAITH, NOT WORKS. (4:1-8)
